



Did You Know?

- Child Labour (Prohibition & Regulation) Amendment Act, 2016, does not consider employment between 14-18 years of age as child labour (unless it is in a hazardous industry).
- Salaam Bombay Foundation Alumni are registered as interns only after procuring a signed consent from their parents as per the requirement of the **Indian Majority Act, 1875**. This allows a minor's guardian to enter into valid contract on his her behalf for the benefit of the minor.
- Interns, while continuing their education, can cater to cyclical and seasonal demands of businesses, eliminating the need for organisations to invest in overheads during lean periods.
 - Unlike apprenticeships which are covered under the **National Apprenticeship Promotion Scheme (NAPS) 2016**, internships are not governed by any regulation, providing for greater flexibility in designing internship programmes for your organization.


